

FINAL EVALUATION MEETING REPORT

May 23th-24th 2018, Carpi - Italy

Wednesday 23th of May

Morning session

We worked on the final report evaluating the results of each project's action. Each partner focused on the aspects concerned his organisation, in order to accurately document them in the final report. We resumed the actions related to Project Management, Implementation, Transnational Project Meetings, Learning/Teaching/Training Activities. We also shared the impact and effectiveness of local seminars, organised in each community. It was interesting to know different methods and "format" adopted by each partner to involve local network of stakeholders interested in the project's contents and results.

Afternoon session

We shared the planning of dissemination activities in each community, according what we defined in the application form. We also defined the characteristics of the dissemination materials, agreed during the previous meeting. We decided to create two of the three tools included in the last report.

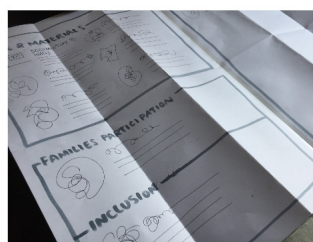

A poster's section is reserved to good ideas that may be developed by each partner, as suggestions or insights to improve the quality and accessibility of ECEC services.
