The National Education Act

- All children and youths shall have equal access to education
- In cooperation with the homes promote their harmonius development to responsible human beings and members in the community
- All education throughout the public school system is free of charge

Compulsory education

- Preschool class (6 years)
- Regular compulsory school (from 7 to 16 years)
- Sami school (from 7 to 12 years)
- Special school (10-year program)
- School for children with learning disabilities (10year program)
- Independent schools (4 per cent of the children)
- International schools (children of foreign nationals)

<u>After school care</u>

- for children 6 to 12 years
- leisure-time centre often integrated into the compulsory school
- pedagogical activities focus on social upbringing
- for children whose parents work or study, are unemployed or on parental leave
- parents pay a fee for their children





Preschools



from the outside





<u>Preschool</u>

- available for children aged 1 5 years
- whose parents work or study
- for children with a particular need for such activities
- children of unemployed
- persons on parental leave
- children aged 4 5 years are entitled to preschool
 3 hours a day free of charge

- In preschool much of the learning takes place when children are playing
- In school theoretical studies are inforced by practical activities
- This way the children's creativity is developed

- School meals are free of charge for the pupils
- The pupils can choose between one traditional hot course and one vegetarian
- Special food is served for medical, religious or ethnical reasons. No extra charge for that.
