Regulatory framework

THE LAW: THE KINDERGARTEN

ACT (1996, officially consolidated text, Official Gazette of RS št.100 / 05 and the Law on the Placement of Children with Special Needs -2011 - ZOUPP-1)





Pre-primary education in Slovenia is considered a separate level of educational system. The country has established an integrated approach to pre-school education, combining education, play and child care in preschool institutions.

The basic tasks of pre-school education are to support parents in comprehensive care for children, to improve the quality of family life and to create good conditions for optimal development of children's physical and mental abilities.







Regulatory framework

Curriculum for kindergartens

(1999, Ljubljana: Ministry of Education and Sport)



The principle of cooperation with parents

Parents are the ones who can provide suggestions and concrete activities to enrich the work of the kindergarten.

When working with families, their privacy, culture, identity, language, worldview, values, beliefs, attitudes, habits and customs should be recognized.

The principle of cooperation with the environment and community

Taking into account the diversity and scope of natural and socio-cultural learning resources from environment and community

Consideration of natural and socio-cultural specificities of Childs's backgrounds.





Regulatory framework

ANNUAL WORK PLAN



is by Law official document that defines organization and detailed content of the life and work of kindergarten and it is adopted by the kindergarten's Board.

Planned, systematic and regular involvement of parents in the life and work of kindergarten.

Parents are included in decision-making:

- Board meetings of parents (29 representatives)
- Participation in the council of an institution **kindergarten's Board** (3 representatives)
- Cooperation in kindergarten's fundation (3 representatives).

With the formal and informal forms of cooperation we want to establish a genuine relationship based on trust, tolerance and respect.



Modes and tools of participation



INDIVIDUAL WORK WITH PARENTS

- Every day at the reception, going home
- Individual meetings: once a month to talk, individual interviews; to address educational issues, counseling, coordination of social and family education

COMMON FORMS OF COOPERATION WITH PARENTS

At least two **PARNETS MEETINGS** in a school year:

- in autumn time: presentation and adoption of the pedagogical annual work plan
- in spring time: presentation of the yearly work and progress, joint excursions, working actions

- Parents play and create together with the children



Kindergarten Jelka received a Plaque of capital city of Ljubljana in 2008, which is the highest recognition of the capital of Ljubljana. The plaque was awarded for kindergarten's work which promotes the capital city of Ljubljana and presents itself as a city of progress, cooperation and personal and collective growth for people and by people of all generations.

The Plaque of capital city of Ljubljana was rewarded for following project activities:

- early integrated English language learning,
- acquisition of the certificate of ECO-Schools and Eco-flag and awards for outstanding achievements in improving the environment of the school and the local community by the European Eco school,
- for many years it presents Ljubljana at the Children's international carnival in Opatija -Croatia,
- it is the initiator of international humanitarian actions to help children at home and abroad (collecting toys and urgently needed supplies for the orphaned children in Bosnia, raising funds for children with cerebral palsy, for physically handicapped children, etc.),
- · collaboration with senior citizens and people with disabilities,
- cooperation with other kindergartens (Mengeš, Izola, Škofja Loka, Maribor, Ptuj and Kranjska Gora)
- and raising awareness about the importance of healthy living in young people, in their parents and grandparents in terms of intergenerational integration.







In cooperation with its partners Neuron d.o.o. and Pro Eco d.o.o. in the framework of the Ministry of Education and Sport and with the financing of the European Social Funds, the kindergarten prepared and produced e-learning materials called Playfully with Jelka (Igraje z Jelko).

The material is meant for pre-school children from the age of four, with the assistance of adult for learning, consolidation and upgrading of educational content, which is the subject of Curriculum for kindergartens.
